No Show Policy

Effective January 1, 2018

No Show Policy will apply to **ALL TEE TIME RESERVATIONS.**

- The individual making the reservation, will be automatically charged the entire No Show fee due if players are missing from the group. It is up to the individual reserving the tee time to be personally reimbursed by missing players from the group.

CANCELLATION OF RESERVATIONS

- A reservation may be cancelled up to, but not including 2 calendar days in advance of the playing date after which No Show fees will be charged. Example: a Sunday reservation may be cancelled through Thursday. You may cancel the **entire** reservation using the web site by going to Advance Reservations, Golf Tee Times, My Tee Times and clicking on the shopping cart icon to the right of the reservation being cancelled. You will get a message asking if you want to delete the reservation, click yes and log out. To cancel part of a reservation or if you use the automated telephone reservation system for reservations, call the Starter at 203-531-8253. Note: There is one exception- just as singles can only add on to an existing reservation for 2 or 3; you will not be able to cancel all but one spot unless there are other reservations existing at that tee time besides yours
- You may send substitutes in your place.
- If you still have openings in your reservation **on the day of play only**, you may call the Starter 203 531-8253 who will try to fill the open slots. If unsuccessful, you will be automatically charged.
- If the course is open at a person's tee time and it is raining **at the golf course**, a golfer can declare that they choose not to play and not be charged a No Show fee. This can be done in person or by calling the Starter at 203 531-8253. If it is raining and they choose to play, they may do so.

INCLEMENT WEATHER DELAY AT ANY POINT

- Golfers with a tee time during the delay have the first option of playing when the course is reopened. If the new time is within one hour of the original time, they must play or be charged.
- If the new tee time is **OVER AN HOUR**, **there will be no charge for not playing.**
- Handicapped individuals-If the course is open, but due to extremely wet conditions the cart rule is "cart paths only" those handicapped individuals, as registered with the course, with reservations will have the option to play. If the individual chooses not to play, the No Show fee will not be applied.
- If the course is **CLOSED FOR THE DAY** by Management due to weather conditions, the No Show fee will not be applied.

The Griffith E. Harris Golf Course Management will have the right to fill any vacant spot with individuals waiting to play who do not have reservations.
